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**In Japanese, Kazari means** 'to decorate' or 'to exhibit' and in Melbourne there are few places to buy good quality Japanese art and antiques to decorate or exhibit in ones home. Kazari is one of them, or should we say three of them ... now that they have opened another store.

The three Kazari stores are: 'decorator' - located at 290 Malvern Road, Prahran, 'warehouse' - located at 7-11 Hill Street, Cremorne, (Richmond) and now 'collector' - located at 450 Malvern Road, Prahran.

Collector occupies a large warehouse space that has been beautifully redesigned to cater for Kazari's expanding collection of antique furniture, antiques, fine art and folk art from Japan. It boasts a fluid art space that shows works by established and emerging contemporary

artists and designers, with a focus on those interested in new possibilities in East-West cross-pollination.

At the rear of the store is café Kazari that serves delicious and authentic Japanese food overlooking a sculpture garden. It is open seven days a week for coffee, tea and cake and the most amazing lunches from Monday to Saturday 12 - 2:30pm. The menu changes every few days with about three Japanese dishes. On one particular day there was simmered tofu with thinly sliced pork and leek topping with an arrowroot sauce on the menu. Exquisite.
